Summary

Mrs. Badger reminisces with some memories of her childhood while living at 1341 Browning Avenue. She talks about specific memories that have stuck with her since she was younger than 8 years old. At some points she also discusses when she was living on 21st and 21st including memories of her LDS ward there. The recording ends with a phone call but continues shortly after.

00:11:10	President Harding. US President and entourage drive down 1300 S. Eleanor, age 5, stood on pillar at Browning to wave flag. Barrett?
00:13:18	Browning Ave. Discusses duration of her time on Browning. Bro. Ted Ashton born there. Mother bore all six children at home.
00:14:30	2100 S and Parley's Ward. Tells about move from Browning to 2100 S. Talks about pictures of old and new Parley's Ward buildings, past bishops (Cannon, Jenko, Clinton?, etc. [names unclear]), ward reunion
00:18:54	Trolley Car. Describes trolley route down 1300 S to East High and down to 900 E.
00:19:22	Phone rings.
