- City Council retreat held to review and set goals
 - Develop cohesive economic development plan; to spread out burden of property taxes
 - Improve street infrastructure (roads, sidewalks, gutters)
 - Work with county and state for funding to address chronic homelessness and build low income housing
- Pleased with return to police beat system
- Q&A
 - Air quality – SLC is in a tough spot. Plan to work with county and state.
 - Economic development and air quality – adversely affects some potential business but SLC has lost out more due to poor of messaging.
 - Dog parks – Rotary Glen approved; looking at pilot projects including Wasatch Hollow (not as a dog park)
 - Emergency preparedness – City working with CERT. Need to educate the public.
