- Speaking on behalf of **Utah Citizens Advocating Renewable Energy (UCARE)**, to discuss Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) rate hike request:
  - Want to increase monthly service charge to \$15/solar user
  - Want to impose a surcharge based on maximum grid use in a one hour period
  - Decrease the reimbursement rate for rooftop solar users from 11 cents/kWh to about 3 cents/kWh.
- The **Public Service Commission (PSC)** will take public comments until the public hearing scheduled for August 9.
